

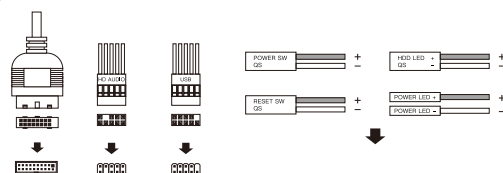

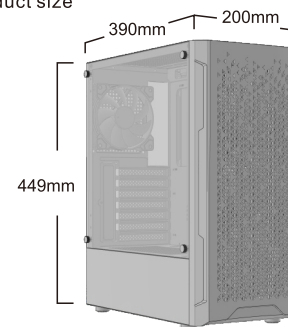

B Schematic diagram of wire interface

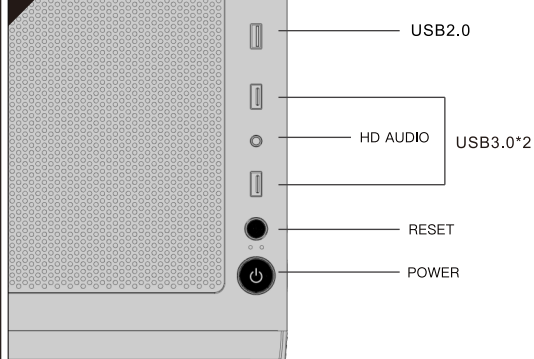

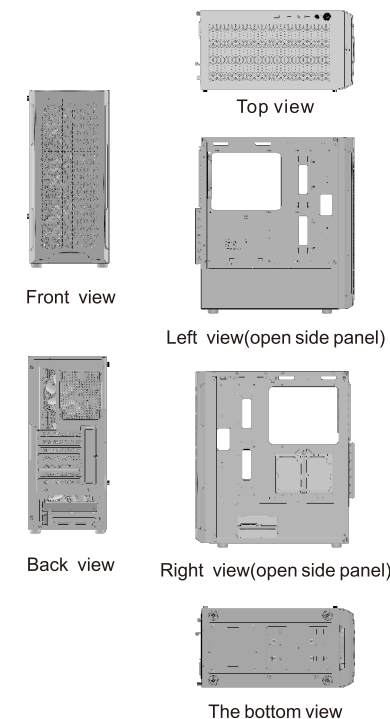

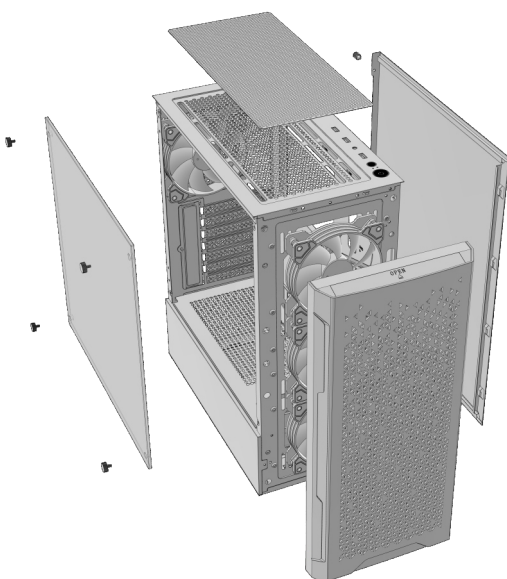

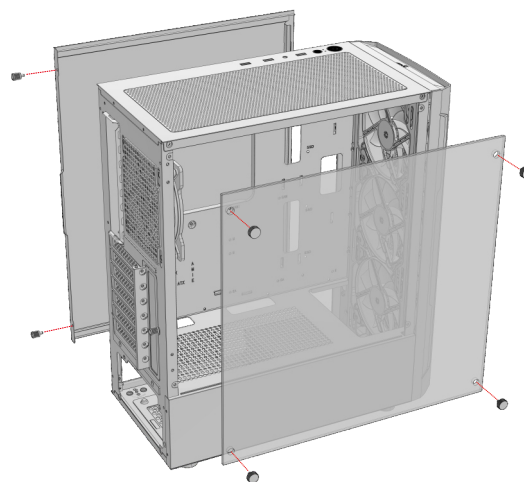
E Machine overview



F Chassis disassembly diagram



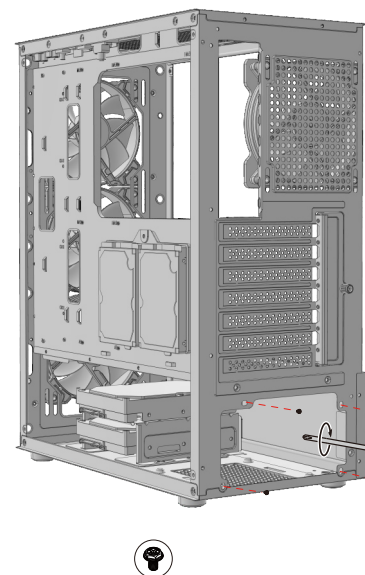
G Remove and install glass side panels



Glass side panel installation: fix the glass side panel with 4 screws (as shown above)

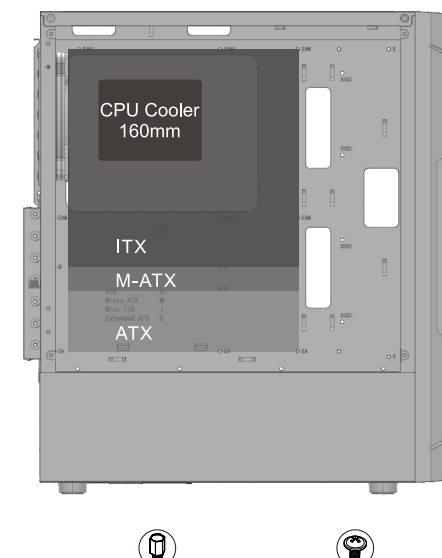
Metal side plate installation: buckle the side plate and fix it with two screws

H The power supply installation



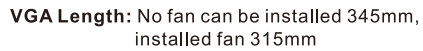
The power supply can be fixed by aligning the screw in the figure to the hole position

I Motherboard installation

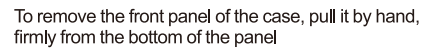


According to the motherboard type (ATX/M-ATX/ITX), the copper pillars may need to be re-arranged manually according to the fixing locations specific to your motherboard

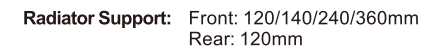
