

Endorfy Fera 5 ARGB (EY3A007)

Someone said that coolers can be either beautiful or efficient. Show them ours - the Endorfy Fera 5 ARGB is quite and looks great.

It's just 15.5 cm at its highest point, but it will cool down almost any processor with ease. It also fits in compact cases and gives them an impressive makeover with ARGB lighting. Your mum will want one for herself (our mums have already demanded theirs).

The heart of the Endorfy Fera 5 is the Fluctus 120 PWM ARGB fan combined with a densely ribbed heat sink. It brings the temperature down without making any unnecessary noise. This is convenient e.g., if you talk to your friends a lot - we all know how much a monotonous hum can interfere with chatting with your crew.

In addition, you can install the Endorfy Fera 5 ARGB on the most popular sockets. Assembling it is a piece of cake, and even hardware newbies can manage thanks to our video tutorial.

We've spent the best years of our lives testing coolers, and we have one thing to say - the Fera 5 ARGB is one of the quietest in its class. You can render graphics, edit a vlog, and chat with your crew, and it'll still be quieter than a mosquito.

By the way - the best years of our lives were best exactly because we had the opportunity to experiment with heat sinks

Airflow is handled by the award-winning Fluctus 120 PWM ARGB fan with an optional semi-passive mode. Its blades have been profiled to cover the densely structured radiator ribs as tightly as possible. We have this theory that if we made it large enough, another ice age would ensue - it handles keeping your CPU cool perfectly.

In addition, each of the blades is finished with a wavy edge that reduces the audibility of annoying noise (psychoacoustic optimization of Fluctus fans is patent pending).

Air conditioning for your CPU

Nothing is as annoying as your computer stuttering when you are in the midst of a virtual skirmish or have some quick 3D rendering to do. We know that these situations take the joy of clicking away, and we've made sure that the Fera 5 ARGB is like an A/C unit for your weary processor.

This is possible thanks to an asymmetric heat sink with dense fins, which efficiently absorbs thermal energy. Its compact base touches the processor's surface, and four heat pipes improve the transfer of heat. The Fera 5 ARGB is also optimized for unidirectional airflow, providing top cooling performance. When your friends see this kit at your place, they will run to order one for themselves – before you even manage to give them something to drink

Stay alpha RGB, baby

If you're a fan of hardware that attracts attention and looks out of this world, then you're going to love the Fera 5 ARGB. Colored backlighting is a terrific thing if you like to sit at your computer in the dark or want your battle station to give your jealous buddies hypertension.

With ARGB illumination, you can match the appearance of the cooler to your battle station. Make it glow in any color (you have 16 million options to choose from) or use effects - a shimmering rainbow or a pulsating wave.

The Fera 5 ARGB works just as well as its non-backlit sister. They share the same design; we'd never sacrifice performance for a cool look.

Nano-Reset controller

The Fera 5 ARGB lets you shine even if you don't have a compatible motherboard or a case with a controller. The kit includes a Nano-Reset ARGB controller that lets you set any illumination effect you want. Have fun!
